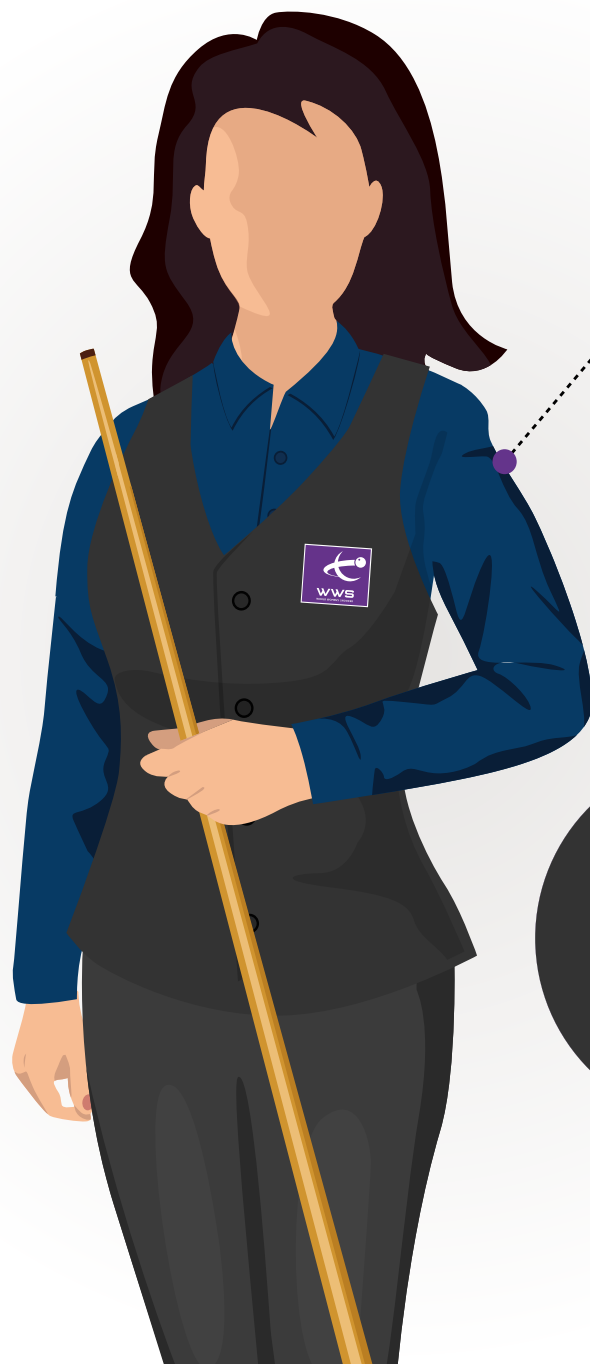




WORLD WOMEN'S SNOOKER DRESS CODE GUIDELINES





FORMAL SHIRTS/BLOUSES

- A shirt/blouse, intended to be worn with a suit jacket, with full buttoning down the front and typically having long sleeves with barrel or single/double cuffs, and a soft or starched collar, suitable for the wearing of a necktie or bow tie.
- For events with a bow tie / necktie where the full dress is applied, the top button of the shirt/blouse may be undone providing it gives the appearance of being fastened or is covered by the bow tie. The use of button-extendors is permitted.
- Shirts/blouses must be tucked in the trousers and long enough to ensure this is the case throughout the entire duration of the match.
- Shirts/blouses must be **clean** and **ironed**.
- Sleeves must be rolled down during play.





BOW TIE/NECKTIE

- A bow tie/necktie is optional unless competing in a broadcast match or otherwise specified within the tournament entry pack.



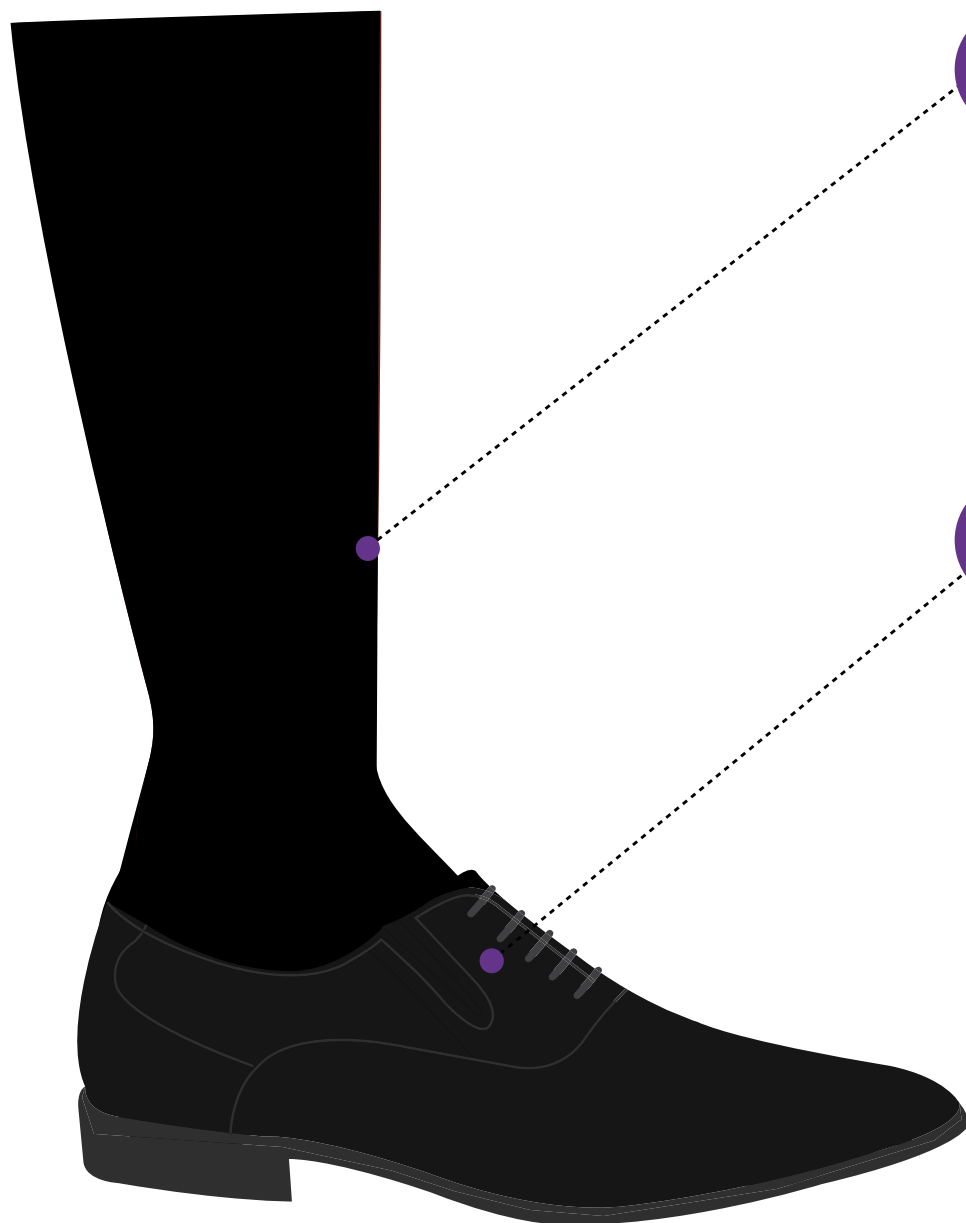
WAISTCOAT

- A tailored waistcoat where the bottom button of the waistcoat need not be fastened. For the avoidance of doubt, all other buttons on the waistcoat must be fastened.
- Neckholder waistcoats are not permitted.



TROUSERS

- Traditional tailored dress trousers without stitched-on, jeans like, pockets and no metal button closure.
- Must be at least 7/8 length, not shorts or 3/4 length.
- Trousers with cuts or rips are not permitted.
- Trousers: Jeans, leggings or chino style trousers are not permitted.



SOCKS

- Socks must be in-keeping with the style of suit being worn both in terms of length and colour.
- Tights and pop socks are permitted
- Patterns and coloured socks are permitted.
- White athletic socks are not permitted.



SHOES

- Formal shoes of a style that is befitting whilst wearing a Dress or Lounge suit (commando or lug soles are not permitted).
- Sport shoes, trainers/sneakers and, high boots are not acceptable.
- Shoes must be **clean**.





TOUR EVENTS

- A maximum of four sponsor logos, to include a Tournament logo (if applicable) are to be worn at any one time. Any requirement to wear a Tournament logo will be stated in the event entry pack.
- Players are also required to wear the WWS logo and optionally may wear their national flag/federation logo. For the avoidance of doubt they may not wear the flag of any other country.
- All logos must be worn on the waistcoat and/or shirt sleeves and cannot exceed 6 square inches in size each. A maximum of two sponsor logos, not including WWS/ national flag logos, are to be worn on one side of the waistcoat.
- No other logo should be placed above either the WWS or Tournament logo.
- It is the player's responsibility if a foul is committed by a personal sponsor logo. If the logo is provided by WWS then no foul is committed.

BROADCAST EVENTS

- Additional rules may be enforced for Broadcast Events e.g. Women's Tour Championship. Please refer to the event entry pack for details.

BOW TIE/NECKTIE

- Unless otherwise specified by the entry conditions of a tournament, this must be a Standard bow tie, or a Crossover bow tie.
- Bow ties must be tightened onto the shirt/blouse collar so that they substantially obscure the view of both button and/or button-extender.
