WSF NATIONALITY POLICY



The World Snooker Federation (WSF) will accept a player's chosen nationality based on the following criteria being met.

- 1. Proof of Birthplace
- 2. Proof of Citizenship acknowledged by Home Office or similar body of the players country with no specific requirement as to the length of residence.

It may be possible for a player to change his or her nationality. Any player wishing to change their nationality must be able to provide documentary evidence. A change of nationality will only be considered providing:

- 1. No previous nationality change has been made.
- 2. There has been no previous international representation for any other country as a snooker player during the previous 3 years.
- 3. That evidence can be provided of 36 consecutive months residency in the players chosen country.

This period may be reduced or even cancelled, subject to the agreement of the WSF board and only following a review by an independent panel taking into account the circumstances of each individual case.

These rules were approved by the WSF board on the 25th of February 2018.
