

## WSF NATIONALITY POLICY



**The World Snooker Federation (WSF) will accept a player's chosen nationality based on the following criteria being met.**

1. Proof of Birthplace
2. Proof of Citizenship acknowledged by Home Office or similar body of the players country with no specific requirement as to the length of residence.

**It may be possible for a player to change his or her nationality. Any player wishing to change their nationality must be able to provide documentary evidence. A change of nationality will only be considered providing:**

1. No previous nationality change has been made.
2. There has been no previous international representation for any other country as a snooker player during the previous 3 years.
3. That evidence can be provided of 36 consecutive months residency in the players chosen country.

***This period may be reduced or even cancelled, subject to the agreement of the WSF board and only following a review by an independent panel taking into account the circumstances of each individual case.***

These rules were approved by the WSF board on the 25th of February 2018.
