<b>Eligibility:</b>	<p>The entry format for this event shall be nomination by National Federation and players will be eligible for nomination as follows:</p> <p>National Federations may nominate players as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All National Federations may nominate EIGHT players.</li> <li>Additionally, players ranked inside of the top 30 of the WWS Rankings following the Festival of Women's Snooker (16/04/2019) will qualify for the tournament outside of the standard allocation of each National Federation. These players must still be entered to compete by their National Federation.</li> </ul> <p>For example, Thailand may nominate up to 11 players (x3 top 30 players, plus their standard allocation of eight players).</p> <p><b>Players must be a member of their National Federation to enter the event.</b></p>

<b>Seeding cut-off:</b>	<p>The official two-year WWS Rankings after the 2019 Festival of Women's Snooker shall be used to seed this event.</p>
<b>Seeding and PR activities:</b>	<p>There will be two seeded players allocated to each group during the round-robin stages (subject to change depending on the number of entries). Seeding will be based upon the WWS Rankings and the winners of events staged by Regional Federations.</p> <p>Players of the same nationality shall be separated in the round-robin group draw where possible.</p>
<b>Logos and brand exclusion:</b>	<p>Players are permitted to wear up to four logos.</p> <p>WWS will retain up to two logos, patches to be provided on arrival:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• WWS logo</li> <li>• Hi-End Snooker Club logo</li> </ul> <p>These logos must be placed in a prominent position (i.e. chest area).</p>
<b>Hotels:</b>	<p>Our hosts at the Hi-End Snooker Club have secured <b>FREE</b> accommodation for players at the following hotel:</p> <p><a href="#"><u>Malaysia Hotel</u></a></p> <p>Distance to venue: 19.5 km / 12.1 miles - Please note that due to heavy traffic this can take up to two hours.</p> <p>Players travelling alone will be asked to share a twin room with another player (please indicate who on entry, if this is not indicated players will be allocated rooms on a random basis). Players travelling with a guest will be able to share with their guest at no extra charge.</p> <p>Hi-End Snooker will arrange transportation for players from the airport to this hotel.</p> <p>There will be a shuttle service arranged by Hi-End Snooker to/from the venue once per day and there is a direct train between hotel/venue.</p> <p>Players are strongly encouraged to stay at the official hotel as this will make pick-up/drop-off arrangements easier.
