Eligibility:	<p>Each National Federation shall be able to nominate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Up to a maximum of two teams, each consisting of two players, EXCEPT for the host nation Thailand which may nominate up to four teams.• Should a National Federations wish to replace a player after the entry deadline a replacement player may be nominated. This cannot be switched back and players may not be rotated during the event. <p>Players must be a member of their National Federation to enter the event.</p>

Dress code:	<p>Long sleeved shirt or blouse, waistcoat & optional bow tie with smart trousers or skirt & smart shoes (no boots / trainers).</p> <p>Please refer to our Standard Terms of Entry below for full information on what is permitted and for the consequences of any breach of the dress code.</p>
Seeding cut-off:	<p>The official two-year WWS Rankings after the 2019 Festival of Women's Snooker shall be used to seed this event.</p>
Seeding and PR activities:	<p>There will be two seeded teams (subject to change depending on number of team entries) allocated to each group during the round-robin stages. Seeding will be based upon the WWS Rankings.</p> <p>Teams shall be separated by nationality at the round-robin group stage.</p>
Logos and brand exclusion:	<p>Players are permitted to wear up to four logos. WWS will retain up to two logos, patches to be provided on arrival:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WWS logo • Hi-End Snooker Club logo <p>These logos must be placed in a prominent position (i.e. not low on waistcoat).</p>
Hotels:	<p>Our hosts at the Hi-End Snooker Club have secured FREE accommodation for players at the following hotel:</p> <p>Malaysia Hotel Distance to venue: 19.5 km / 12.1 miles - Please note that due to heavy traffic this can take up to two hours.</p> <p>Players travelling alone will be asked to share a twin room with another player (please indicate who on entry, if this is not indicated players will be allocated rooms on a random basis). Players travelling with a guest will be able to share with their guest at no extra charge.</p> <p>Hi-End Snooker will arrange transportation for players from the airport to this hotel.</p> <p>There will be a shuttle service arranged by Hi-End Snooker to/from the venue once per day and there is a direct train between hotel/venue. Please note that due to local traffic the journey between hotel and venue may take approximately two hours.</p> <p>Players are strongly encouraged to stay at the official hotel as this will make pick-up/drop-off arrangements easier.
